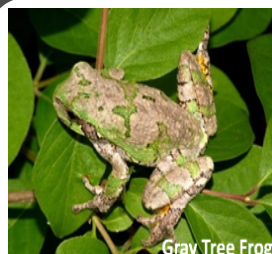

REMINDERS

- Monitor at least 30 minutes after sunset
- 2 minutes acclimation, 3 minutes to monitor (if interrupted, start over including acclimation)
- 0 = no frogs, 1= one frog, 2= pair of frogs, 3 = full chorus
- If below 35F, too windy (4+ on Beaufort scale), or raining hard DO NOT MONITOR
